# ONE MIND: THE MIND OF CHRIST

COLOSSIANS 3:2 NLT

***THINK ABOUT THE THINGS OF HEAVEN, NOT THE THINGS OF EARTH.***

Our mind controls absolutely everything. The way we perceive everyday situations, our concepts of ourselves, others, and even God. Our mood, our ability or inability to accomplish anything, what we believe, and therefore, our capacity to enjoy God's promises—everything is governed by the mind.

*Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.*

**Romans 12:2 NIV**

Culture—the way of thinking we grew up with—can be renewed by changing what we see and hear. In other words, when we change what we feed our minds, they can be renewed.

Generally, we feed on everything the world offers us: music, television, news, social media, the people we spend time with, what we read, and so on. This filters and shapes everything we think and how we see our lives.

*Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes.*

**Ephesians 4:23 NLT**

There are two ways of thinking: the world's way, also known as "the flesh", or God's way, also known as the "Spirit". Our Heavenly Father desires that we allow Him to renew our minds and that our thoughts become his thoughts; it is the only way to experience that his will is good, pleasing, and perfect.

*For, "Who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?" But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.*

**1 Corinthians 2:16 NLT**

Is there any area of your life that isn't good, pleasing, or perfect?

If the answer is "yes," I invite you to examine your thoughts about this area and compare them to God's perspective.

For example:

How is your mood? Do you live in peace without anger or resentment? Do you feel happy and fulfilled?

If the answer is "no", what do you think about this? Do you think that you will achieve happiness later on, when you have money, get married, or finish your studies?

Compare this to what God says:

*You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!*

**Isaiah 26:3 NLT**

According to this verse, living in perfect peace depends on continually meditating on his Word, trusting in it, and focusing our thoughts on our God and Father. To live in that peace is to know and trust in his plan, his designs, and his promises.

*Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.*

**Joshua 1:8 NLT**

According to what God says, the fact that we succeed in everything we do and prosper in everything we undertake is the result of meditating on his Word; that is, it is the result of the renewal of our minds through his Word, which enables us to identify with and have his thoughts. This is what it means to have the mind of Christ.

**Application:**

- What occupies most of your thoughts?
- Do you understand that if you have the mind of Christ, you will share the same way of thinking as your Heavenly Father and all his children? That only in this way can we be one church in Him?
- What decision will you make today to be ONE with Him, to share his mind, and thus enjoy his peace, joy, and righteousness in everything?

## Prayer

Father, today I choose to focus my gaze on heavenly things and stop being preoccupied with all that is earthly. Today, according to Your Word and Your will, I ask You to help me develop the mind of Christ. I no longer want to conform to this world. I want to stop fighting against Your will and be truly transformed by You. Holy Spirit, today I confess with my mouth that You have all authority to renew my thoughts and attitudes. I desire to know the thoughts of my Heavenly Father. Jesus, You have given me Your mind and understanding. Today, I choose to meditate continually on Your Word and trust in it to be completely transformed. In this way, I will be able to verify that Your will is good, pleasing, and perfect.

Thank You because I know I have the mind of Christ, so that I can think like my Father in Heaven and live guided by Your Holy Spirit. In Jesus' name. Amen!
