ONE FAMILY

EPHESIANS 2:19 NLT

SO NOW YOU GENTILES ARE NO LONGER STRANGERS AND FOREIGNERS. YOU ARE CITIZENS ALONG WITH ALL OF GOD'S HOLY PEOPLE. YOU ARE MEMBERS OF GOD'S FAMILY.

One of the most beautiful revelations of the gospel is that, through Christ and thanks to what He did on the cross, God not only saves us but also adopts us. We are now His children; He is no longer just our God but also our Father. We are His family.

Scripture teaches us several truths: in Christ we have identity. In Christ we have belonging. In Christ we have restored relationships. In Christ we have purpose and abundant life. God is not forming an organization, a cold institution, or a religious club; it is not a matter of doctrines or theological positions. He is forming a community called family. Everything God designed was designed with the family in mind, and from there, everything else is reproduced. From the beginning, God's design was familial: Adam and Eve. Parents and children. Generations walking together.

The family is the basic unit of society. If we want to see real and lasting changes in society, we must be aware that these changes don't begin in governments or systems; they begin in the family. A healthy society is a reflection of healthy families. A broken society reveals broken families. That's why the enemy attacks the family because, by destroying it, he weakens everything else and distorts the image of God.

The family reflects the image of God. The Bible says that God is ONE, but He manifests Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; they are not three gods, but one God in perfect unity. In the same way, the family reflects that unity: Father, Mother, Children; when the family walks in unity, love, and purpose—it reflects the heart of God on earth. Unity manifests the authority of God.

God is not an authoritarian Father. His authority flows from love. The same is true in the family: leadership is born of love, obedience is born of trust, and unity is born of commitment.

Before speaking of the Kingdom in the church or throughout society, we must live it at home. We must demonstrate its principles through daily life, for example: Protecting one another by watching over each other, creating a safe emotional and spiritual environment, speaking words that build up and affirm, providing not only material things, but also spiritual and emotional support. Leading and guiding by example, not just words. In this way, the family becomes the first place where we learn who God is and what He is like: His character, His desires, His faithfulness, His wonderful plan for us.

The family of God transcends blood ties; it is a spiritual entity with an eternal purpose; that is why Jesus expands the concept of family:

Anyone who does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother!
Matthew 12:50 NLT

God's family isn't limited to blood ties, but is based on obedience, faith, and a relationship with the Father. All of this is aimed at leading us to the point of fully trusting Him. That is what the church is: a spiritual family where we care for one another, restore one another, and walk together doing God's will.

God has always desired to form a family, not just saved individuals. A family united around His Word, His covenant, and His will. When we understand that we are family, we stop competing and judging, and we begin to love one another and build God's house together.

And you are living stones that God is building into his spiritual temple...
1 Peter 2:5 NLT

We are citizens of the Kingdom, but also children of the Father. We are not alone. We are one big house, one spiritual family throughout the world.
